From fishing and aquaculture, to sports, tourism and maritime transports, the importance of activities linked to the sea in Galicia and Northern of Portugal is self-speaking. These are omnipresent and make part of the day to day scenery. However, their diversity and multiplicity of challenges faced by maritime professionals require on-going vigilance and tools to assist their decision making.

The four year (2011-2015) INTERREG project <u>RAIA-CO</u> addressed this challenge by improving transboundary (ES/PT) ocean observations and prediction mechanisms, allowing for the production of extremely valuable oceanographic and meteorological information for the management and exploitation of resources and activities. Furthermore, the project has enabled the co-development, with end users, of services and products using the collected marine data and contributing directly to the productivity, sustainability and competitiveness of coastal activities.

Outcomes of the project

Different services and online tools such as upwelling index, specific forecast to harbors and ports and specific products for fishing and aquaculture activities.
