Overview

Atlantic Youth is an **Erasmus + Strategic Partnership** in the field of Education, Training, and Youth. It involves 5 countries: Ireland, Spain, France, Portugal and the United Kingdom. The objective is to **develop and value maritime and inclusive educational initiatives at school**.

Six partners are committed to the implementation of the project: Comunidade Intermunicipal of Alto Minho (PT); Patronato Municipal de Deportes de Ayamonte (ES); Centre de Moulin Mer (FR); Cornwall Marine Network (UK); Clare County Council (IE). All of them are currently working together to successfully complete the project (**which runs from 2017-2021**), the final conference will take place on 29th May 2020.

Cycles of local actions in inclusive maritime education in secondary schools:

30th September 2017 – 16th May 2018: 323 pupils attended.

30th September 2018 – 17th May 2019: more than 350 pupils attended.

Transnational events for the classes and pupils which participate in the local actions:

First transnational event: 26th May – 1st June 2018: 108 college students from five European countries hosted in Ennis, Co Clare, (IE).

Second transnational event: 27th May – 31st May 2019: 109 college students from five European countries have lived the first “European Sea Class” in the Moulin-Mer nautical centre (FR).

Third transnational event: 25th May – 29th May 2020, planned in Viana do Castelo, (PT).
