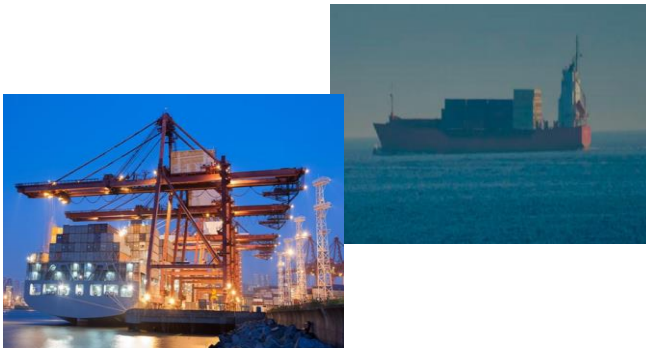
Overview

- 1) Smart port
- 2) Smart ship
