Overview

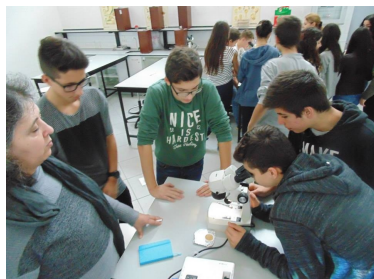
The objective of the Ocean Action project, coordinated by CIIMAR, is to increase knowledge of the principles of Ocean Literacy and the impact of pollution at sea, as well as to promote conservation of marine ecosystems.

In order to achieve these objectives, different initiatives were developed to raise awareness among the School Communities and the general public:

- **Lectures and experimental science activities** in elementary and secondary schools of the Greater Porto region
- Development and availability of experimental science protocols to enable practical teaching activities in the classroom
- Production of a travelling **exhibition on the subject of marine pollution**
- **Beach cleaning actions** with schools and other groups
- Production and translation of **animated videos about ocean pollution**
- Production of electronic **games focusing on the problem of ocean contamination**
- Production of large **sculptures made with recycled plastic** and a theater play about this problem, for exhibition in public areas and schools of the city of Porto
- **National competition** for schools in the region and general public **on the subject of ocean pollution**, in the modalities of awareness panels, recycled art, photography and infography.

- Encouraged critical reflection on the problem of marine waste and the need to adopt environmentally responsible behaviors for the population.
- Awareness raising among the new generation on the problem of marine ecosystem conservation.
