Since our last e-newsletter in September, three pillar workshops have been conducted:


- Staying Connected for Trade, Tourism and Economic Growth, 16 September (Pillar I),

### The Atlantic Stakeholder Platform Conference (ASPC) 2021 was a success!

The 8th Atlantic Stakeholder Platform Conference (ASPC 2021) was held on Thursday, 21 October 2021 and attracted 230 participants from 27 countries. This year's edition was hosted by the Irish Presidency of the Atlantic Strategy Group at the Convention Centre Dublin, Ireland.

The conference featured prominent figures of the Blue Economy, including **Virginijus Sinkevičius**, EU Commissioner for Environment and Oceans; **Charlie McConalogue**, Irish Minister for Agriculture, Food and the Marine; and **Christos Economou**, Acting Director of the Directorate for Maritime Policy and Blue Economy, DG MARE (European Commission) among other key actors.


Dymphna Keogh, 2021 Atlantic Strategy Committee Chair and the four Pillar Coordinators introduced the Atlantic Action Plan 2.0 updates. The remaining sessions consisted of keynote speeches, project pitches, four stakeholder workshops, a discussion with the Youth Ocean Ambassadors and a presentation of Mission Ocean.

Our virtual exhibition allowed 16 projects to be featured through virtual booths.




